Up to now, more than 4000 cases of robotic HPB surgery had been performed by his team, ranking the first in terms of the total number in the world. Prof. Liu held "Beijing International Minimally Invasive Surgery Forum" every year, which attracted experts from various developed countries and regions to visit and learn.
