Pediatric Surgery International JSPS Issue Submission Guidelines

Deadline for Full Manuscript Submission: Papers must be received by 24:00 (Tokyo time) on the 17th April 2026 (Friday). No exceptions given!

Only authors whose submitted abstracts were selected for presentation at the 63rdd Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Pediatric Surgeons (JSPS) (June 11-13, 2026, Nagoya), may submit their papers to be considered for publication in the Pediatric Surgery International (JSPS Issue). Any type of presentation including poster presentations will be considered if the abstract is selected for presentation at the 63rd JSPS meeting. However, case reports are not subject to review. The final decision on manuscript acceptance will be made by the PSI (JSPS Issue) Publication Committee, which will meet the day before the Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Pediatric Surgeons. The JSPS Prize will also be awarded to outstanding papers this year.

Important Notices

- 1. Abstracts that have been presented at other meetings, but not at any previous JSPS meeting, and which have not been previously published will be considered for presentation at JSPS 2026.
- 2. The papers mentioned above must have been accepted as an abstract for the 63rd Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Pediatric Surgeons.
- 3. Case reports and papers previously presented at an Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Pediatric Surgeons are not eligible.
- 4. Duplicate submission is not permitted. Papers that are found to be dual submissions will be reported to the PSI secretariat and may be subject to penalties.
- 5. The JSPS Prize will be selected from manuscripts submitted for the JSPS Prize. If you wish to apply for the prize session, you must write a **cover letter in red ink**. Previous recipients of this prize are ineligible.
- 6. Two papers selected for the Prize will be honored at the academic meeting, and a prize of 100,000 yen will be awarded. JSPS will pay for the cost of open access for the best paper.
- The deadline for submission is **24:00 (Tokyo time) on the 17th April 2026 (Friday)**. Submissions received after the deadline will not be reviewed. Full papers must be submitted ELECTRONICALLY to the PSI (JSPS Issue) Publication Committee office. The papers selected for publication will be determined by the Publications Committee.

- · File Format: Please combine the manuscript text, figures, and tables into a single editable Word file and attach it to your email. Use the table function in Word for creating tables. Figures should be created in TIFF format and then pasted into the Word file as described above.
- · File Size: As we are accepting submissions via email, please adhere to the following file size limits: The entire manuscript should be under 15 MB. If the file size is too large, you may compress the manuscript and figures into a single .zip file or send them in separate emails.
- · Please do not include author information in the filenames.
- · Prize Application: If you wish to apply for the JSPS Prize (JSPS Annual Meeting Top Paper), please indicate this in red font in your cover letter. Since scoring is conducted in a blinded format, please submit a separate manuscript version that does not contain author information.
- English Review: If the author is not a native English speaker, a certificate of review by a native English speaker is required. This requirement does not apply to authors from countries where English is the primary language of education. If you believe such a review is unnecessary for other reasons (e.g., a co-author is a native English speaker), please state the reason in your cover letter.
