The Japanese Urological Association (JUA) is a leading academic society with approximately **10,000 members** dedicated to advancing urological research, education, and clinical practice.

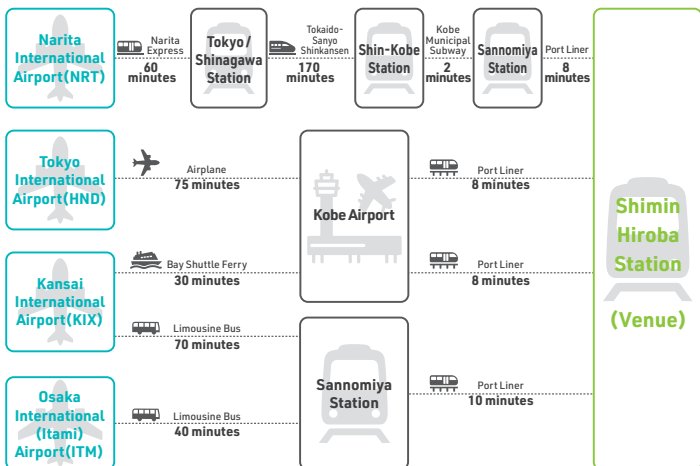
